

**2011 USBC ANNUAL MEETING

DELEGATE REPORT**

The USBC Annual Meeting was called to order by President Darlene Baker and included many highlights for the day. With a little over one thousand delegates including board of directors and 228 non-voting guests in attendance. Highlights included: Award winner video, Star of Tomorrow Award winners, International Bowling Hall of Fame presentation and the Susan Komen Meet for the Cure.

The legislative committee brought forth several changes:

Rule Proposal – to change senior league rules to age 50 instead of 55 – REJECTED

Bylaws Proposal #B1 - Chartering State and Local Bowling Associations by August 1, 2013 – REJECTED

Bylaws Proposal #B2 - Nominations from the floor be changed to 30 days instead of 24 hours - APPROVED

The nominating committee had a slate of seven names for the four open spots. Those elected were incumbents: Darlene Baker and Marci Williams and new directors Jo Dimond and Bill Vint.

New to the convention this year the Hall of Fame ceremony was held Friday evening and was certainly missed during the annual meeting.

In closing out the meeting there was a question and answer session – with several delegates coming from the floor with questions on the future of associations in bowling.

The three day event is filled with workshops of your choice and this year also the finals of the Women's PBA finals that were held at Cowboy Stadium.
