Time Commitments

Board of Directors – 3 to 4 Board meetings per year (two of which, including the Showcase Weekend, are overnight, i.e., more than one day). All usually held in Jefferson City.

Youth Committee – Four to five meetings. Except for Showcase Weekend, most meetings are held in Columbia (early afternoon), on Saturdays when youth leagues are not in session and on Sundays when they are.

NOTE:

Positions on Youth Committee up for election in 2010 are: Area member #2, #4, #6, #8, #10, two At Large Member positions, and two Youth Member positions. (See www.mousbc.org for area map.)

Three Youth Director positions on the Board of Directors are up for election in 2010.

** Note: The RVP requirement for Youth Committee members is a new requirement that must be, per the state association bylaws, approved by the Youth Delegates at the Annual Meeting. This will be voted on prior to the elections.
